### Automated driving – expected advantages:

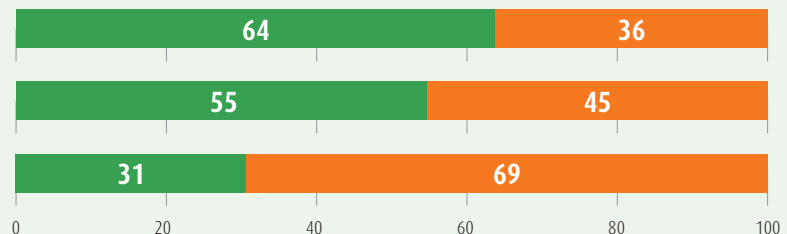

### Automated driving – expected disadvantages:

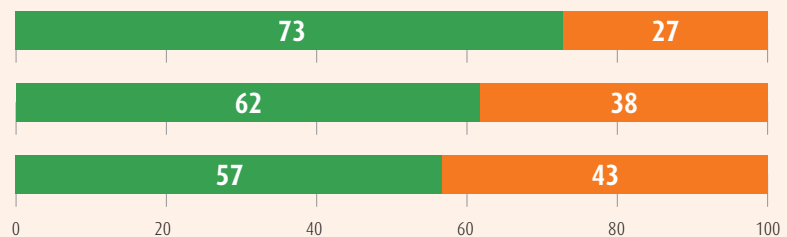
