

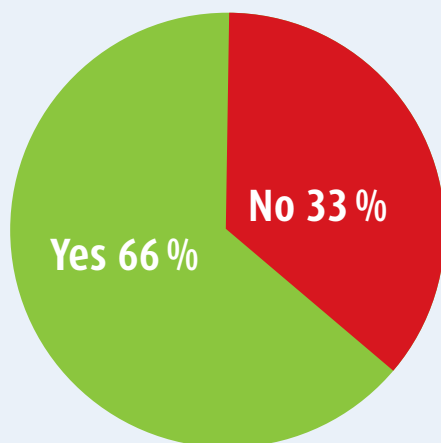


Quote of the Month
