Innovative assistance systems to increase traffic safety:

Intelligent redirection recommendation

Warns of accidents and other traffic obstacles on the planned route and suggests detours.



Intelligent vehicle networking

Enables exchange of information from vehicle to vehicle and transport infrastructure.



eCall

Automatically dials the emergency number and sends information to the rescue services. Reduces the number required time until the rescue team arrives.



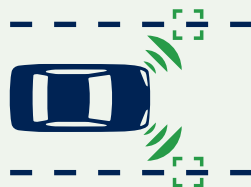
Alcohol Interlock*

Prevents the vehicle from being put into service under the influence of alcohol.



Emergency Brake Assist Systems*

Supports the driver during critical braking actions.



Lane Keeping Warning Systems*

Warns when a lane is crossed, e.g. due to fatigue.



Speed assistance*

Warns with acoustic signals if the speed limit is not maintained and reduces the engines power if necessary.



Adaptive Cruise Control

Gives information on the correct distance to the vehicle in front.
