



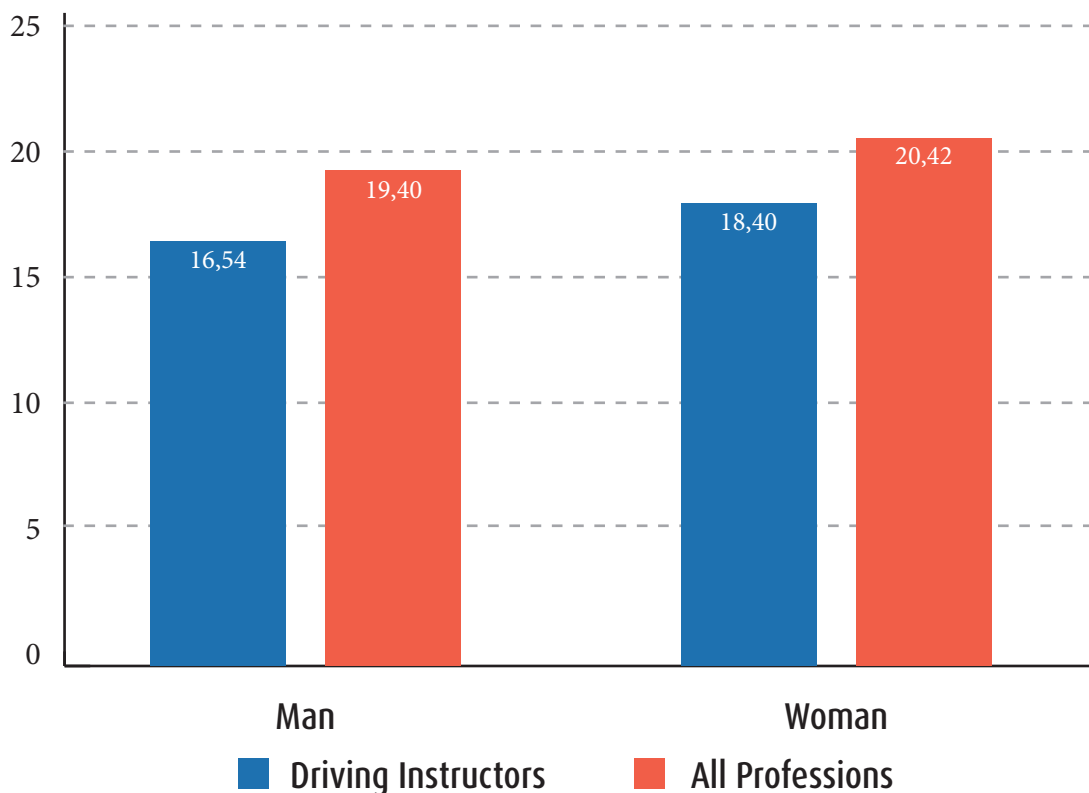
Quote of the month

„Last year, driving instructors were on sick leave for an average of sick* for an average of just under 17 days. That is about 18% less than the national average, which was almost 20 sick days. The AOK statistics also show that female driving instructors took were sick almost 2 days longer than driving instructors in 2020. Driving instructors most frequently suffered from back pain, upper respiratory tract infections and depressive episodes**“
