



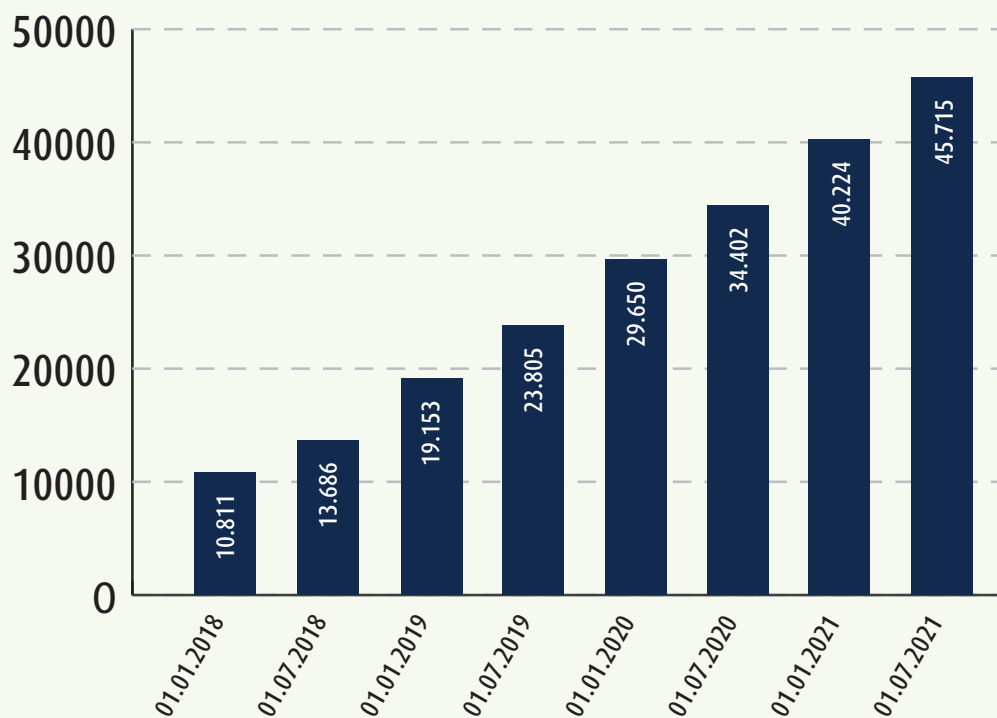
## Quote of the month



„Every year, more and more new electrically powered cars are being registered. Positive trends are also evident in the area of charging infrastructure: The growth in publicly accessible charging points\* from 07.2018 to 07.2021 has increased by 234 %. On 01 November 2021, the Federal Network Agency reported a total of 49,207 such charging points. Currently, Wolfsburg\*\* offers the highest density per 10,000 inhabitants with 65 publicly accessible e-charging points. In second place we find Ingolstadt with just under 30 e-charging stations.“
