„While the previous facts of the month focused on the advantages of being a driving instructor, here we look at the disadvantages. The biggest challenges are the working hours (50.76% of under 25-year-olds, 77.69% of driving instructors) and the work-life balance. Younger people also perceive the high level of responsibility (35.61%), while experienced professionals tend to see the social reputation as a problem (53.85%).“
