



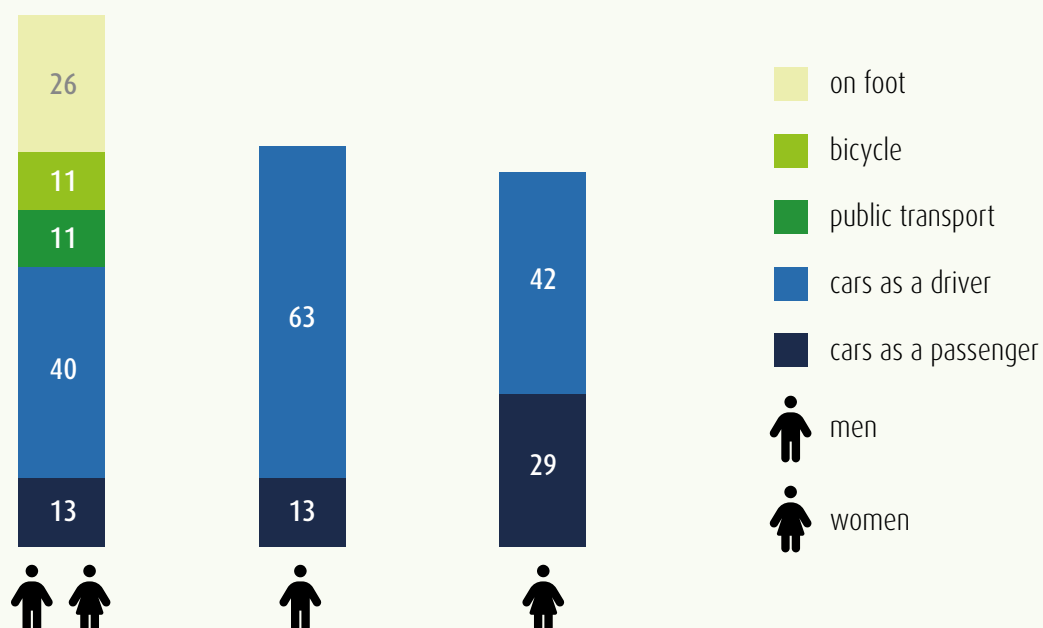
Quote of the month

„In 2023, the volume of traffic in Germany fell slightly to around 250 million journeys per day despite population growth. The distance-related modal split shows that 26% of journeys were made on foot, 11% by bicycle, 11% by public transport, 40% by car as a driver and 13% as a passenger. Men are significantly more likely to drive themselves (63%) than women (42%). Women, on the other hand, are more often passengers (29% compared to 13% of men), as the diagrams illustrate.“
