„Compared to 2023, alcohol-related offenses decreased by 7.8% in 2024 – that’s around 9,000 fewer cases. Drug-related offenses also saw a decline of 3%. New in the statistics: in the very first year of separate tracking, nearly 1,000 cannabis-related offenses were recorded – I’m curious to see how this number will develop in the future. Driving without a license despite a driving ban increased by 3.3% to over 118,000 cases. Particularly striking is the continued rise in illegal motor vehicle races – with an increase of 10.3% compared to the previous year.“
