



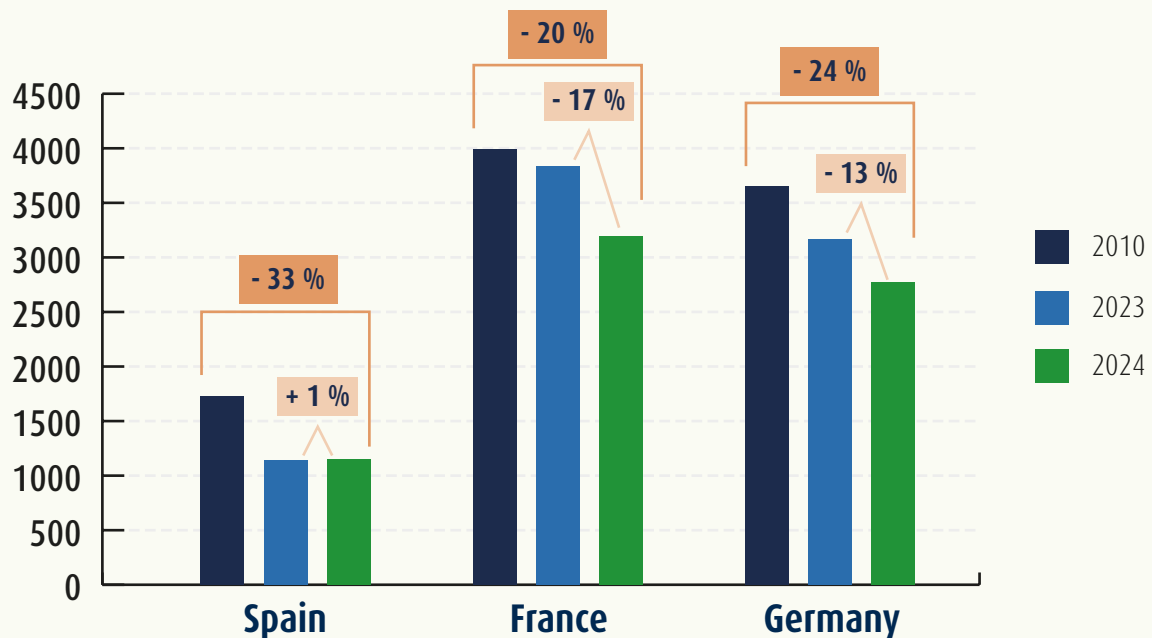
Quote of the month

„The number of traffic fatalities has significantly decreased in all three countries considered since 2010. In Spain, it dropped by 33% (from 1,730 to 1,154), in France by 20% (from 3,992 to 3,193), and in Germany by 24% (from 3,648 to 2,770). However, the comparison between 2023 and 2024 shows a different picture: while France (-17%) and Germany (-13%) recorded significant declines, the number in Spain remained nearly stable (+1%).“

Definition of „Traffic Fatalities“: The number of people killed in road traffic accidents is defined as the number of deaths that occur within 30 days of the date of the accident as a result of road traffic crashes. This includes drivers and passengers of motorized vehicles, cyclists, and pedestrians involved in traffic accidents. The 30-day rule is applied internationally (e.g., by the WHO, the United Nations, and within the EU) to ensure the comparability of accident statistics.
