



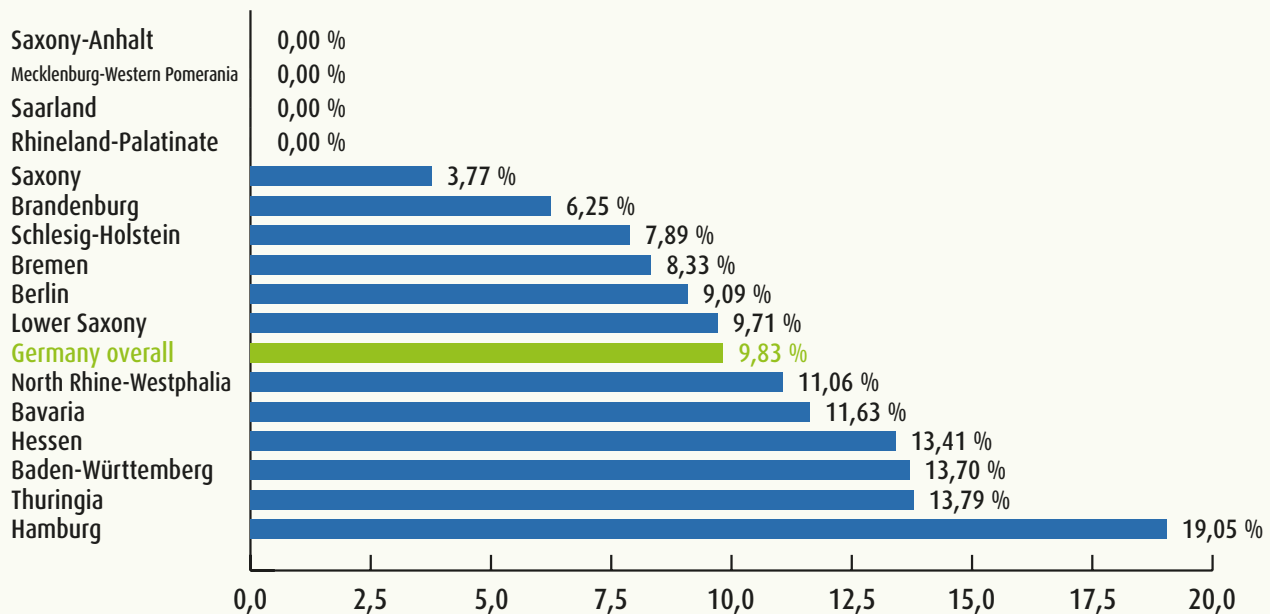
Quote of the month

„According to a representative survey conducted by FINN in July-August 2025, only 9.8% of people in Germany would most likely give up their car. In Rhineland-Palatinate, Saarland, Mecklenburg-Western Pomerania, and Saxony-Anhalt, 0% of respondents said they could do without a car – it is considered a basic requirement for participation and mobility there. In contrast, 19% of respondents in Hamburg stated that they could easily do without a car – supported by a dense public transport network and alternative mobility options.“
