

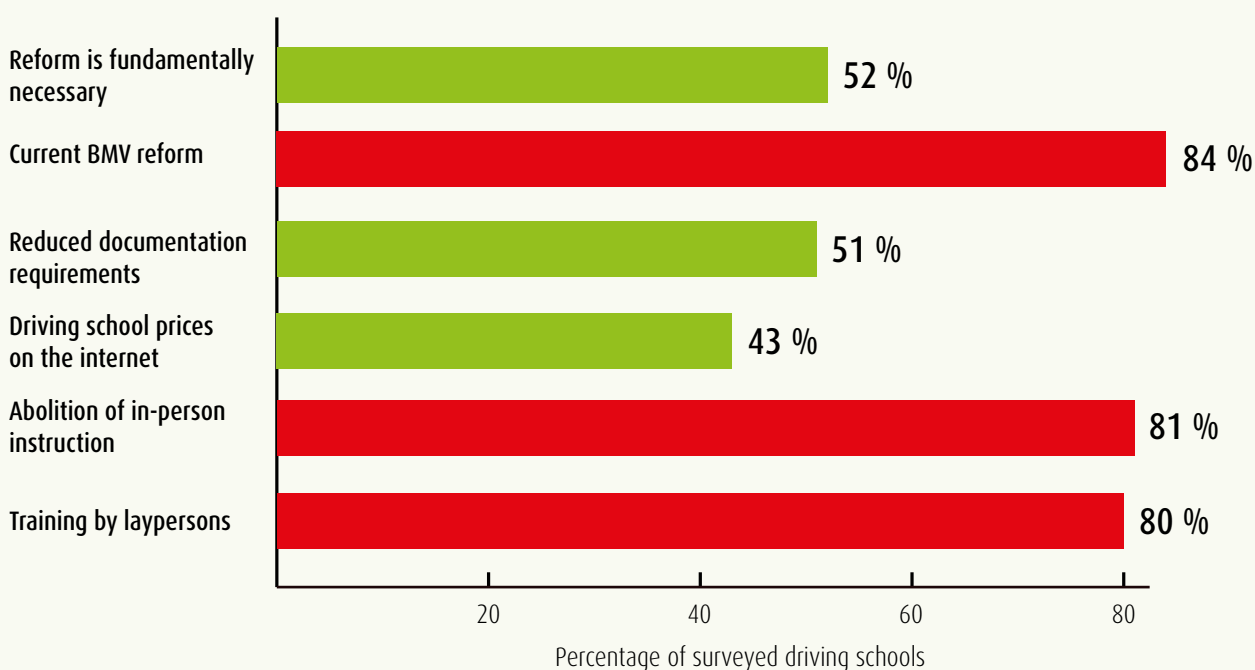


Quote of the month

„The representative MOVING survey presents a nuanced picture: 52% of driving schools consider a reform fundamentally necessary, but 84% rate the current BMV reform predominantly negatively. The aspects viewed positively are mainly the reduction of documentation requirements (51%) and the publication of driving school prices on the internet (43%). Clearly rejected, however, are the abolition of in-person classes (81%) and training by laypersons (80%).“
