



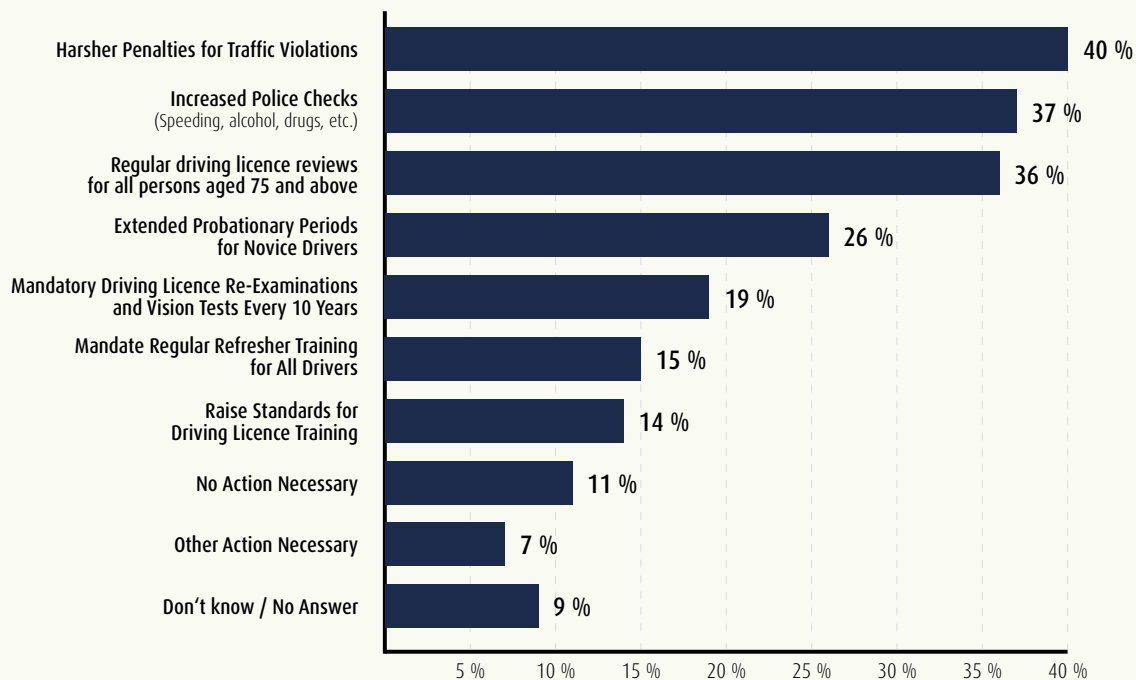
### Quote of the month

„The HUK-Coburg Mobility Study 2026 shows that Germans primarily favor stricter government measures to improve road safety. Forty percent support tougher penalties for traffic violations, while 37 percent call for increased police enforcement. A mandatory reassessment of driving licenses from the age of 75 also enjoys broad approval, with 36 percent in favor. By contrast, measures such as extended probationary periods or regular refresher courses are perceived as less effective, as they are attributed significantly lower impact.“
