„The age profile of the driving instructor workforce clearly underscores the increasing need to attract new talent: as of 1 January 2026, the average age was 53.9 years, and more than 37% of all registered driving instructor licence holders were over the age of 60. In Bremen and Thuringia, more than half are already aged over 60, while Hamburg and Berlin display comparatively younger demographic structures.“
